## The Chain Double Quadrille

Formation: Double Sicilian Progressive, (ie lines of two couples facing two couples, arranged around the hall)

Music: 48 bar Reels / Set tunes
Steps: the first 16 bars may be danced with a travelling step, the remainder is 'walked'

## Introduction: Honour Partner, Honour Opposites,

A1 Middle four people: Right Hand Star, once around (4b), then Left Arm Turn their partner $\mathbf{1 1} 1 / 2$ times to change places with them;

A2 The four now in the middle, similarly: Right Hand Star, once around (4b), then
Left Arm Turn their partner $\mathbf{1} 1 / 2$ times to finish in place;
B1 All Set Twice to partners, and Swing;
B2 Ladies' Chain across the set to the opposite man (4b), who turns the lady to face along his own line, Ladies Chain along the (opposite) line, turning to face back across the set;

C1 Ladies' Chain across the set, then Ladies Chain along their own line, finishing with partner; (NB the Ladies have danced 'around-the-square')

C2 (retaining the 'Ladies' Chain turn hold') as couples: Advance \& Retire, Advance \& Pass On (men passing left shoulder with opposite man);

Repeat with a new line of four, as often as desired.
