Celebration Waltz

Julie Elliott, 1995

Formation: Couples in a circle, progressive.

Music: 32 bar Waltz, with a coda to end the dance. Tempo as for 'Pride of Erin'.

| Introduction: Couples holding hands in a circle, with the Lady on the right of her partner, Honour Partner, Honour Corner, | (4b) |
|---|------------------------------|
| Advance and Retire – 2 waltz steps in, 2 waltz steps out, finish facing partner, | (4b) |
| Turn Partner – open two hand hold, turn once around in 4 waltz steps, finishing back in circle, | (4b) |
| Advance and Retire – 2 waltz steps in, 2 waltz steps out, finish facing corner, | (4b) |
| Turn Corner – open two hand hold, turn once around in 4 waltz steps, finishing facing partner, | (4b) |
| Turn & Chain, 3 places – Right hand turn with partner 1½ times around to progress to the next person, Left hand turn this next person 1½ times around to progress to a third person, Right hand turn this person once around and change to a 'ballroom' hold, Waltz on with this new partner, finishing back in the circle, with the lady on the man's right, | (4b) (4b) (4b) (4b) |
| Coda – at the end of the last time through, add an extra 8 bars for a 'waltz on' finishing with a 'step apart' and 'honour'. | (8b) |

Short Calls:

Advance & Retire; Turn Partner;

Advance & Retire; Turn Corner;

Right Turn & Chain Partner; Left Turn & Chain the next;

Right Turn the third; and Waltz the third;
